

ARRIVAL/DISMISSAL

Arrival: Students may be dropped off as early as 6:45am. Please do not drop students off earlier, as no staff members are assigned to supervise students until that time. When dropping off students in the morning, please use the north entrance and be sure to stay in the lane designated for cars in a single line (to the right) through the main parking area. Please do not drive in the bus lanes (the two lanes closest to school) during arrival or dismissal times. Also, due to safety concerns, students **must** be dropped off at the crosswalks closest to the Main Office (see below). We will also have crossing guards stationed at our main parking lot crosswalk, at the crosswalk at Oak Valley, and at Quarterhorse Trail. **PLEASE STAY IN THE LEFT LANE IF EXITING LEFT, AND STAY IN THE RIGHT LANE IF EXITING RIGHT WHEN POSSIBLE. DO NOT DROP STUDENTS OFF ON KNAUST ROAD.**



Dismissal: During dismissal, bus riders and car riders will exit immediately at 2:20. Parents who pick up are asked to enter the parking lot area only (not the bus loop) and form two lines on either side of the lot (see below). We ask that you leave a gap in the center to allow cars to continue moving through once students have entered each vehicle. This will allow us to clear as much traffic as possible before busses leave the lot.



Transportation: If your child's daily transportation routine changes, please let us know ahead of time, at **636-281-0776**, to make us aware of the change. Students are not allowed to ride home with other students on another bus. If your child needs to ride an unassigned bus because of a significant family-related situation, please alert our transportation office at **636-240-3138**.

Traffic Safety: At dismissal, bus riders and car riders leave immediately, but we hold walkers and bike riders until busses are off of the lot. If you arrive after busses leave campus, please remember to maintain an awareness that our students will be walking and riding bicycles near the roadway. Please avoid any unsafe situations which might put yourself, your child, or other people at risk.

Student Safety: By holding walkers and bike riders in the same classroom every day, we will get to know each child's routine. If we notice a concern with a student walking instead of riding the bus, we will attempt to communicate with parents. We encourage parents to check with your grade level office or talk with your child's teaching team to maintain an awareness of how your student is getting home. Please talk with your child about safe behaviors during these critical times. Our parking lot can be a busy place.
